We reserve the right to refuse entry into any class or onto the grounds. We demand good horsemanship. (All training should be done at home, please set an example for the children and the non-horse spectators.) Each horse may be ran only once per class. A rider can enter and ride many horses, provided each has a different exhibitor's number. Entries for each class will be closed when the proceeding class begins. No refunds. Failure to answer three (3) gate calls will result in an official's scratch. Please be ready to compete. If for any reason the time is not captured, a rerun will be granted to a qualified ride. During the rerun no disqualification will result, provide an honest attempt is made at the pattern, which is the judge's decision. Any announcements will take precedence over show bill with the exemption of class order, start times and payout.
